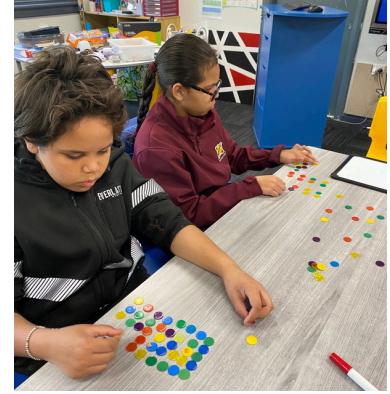




Classroom News

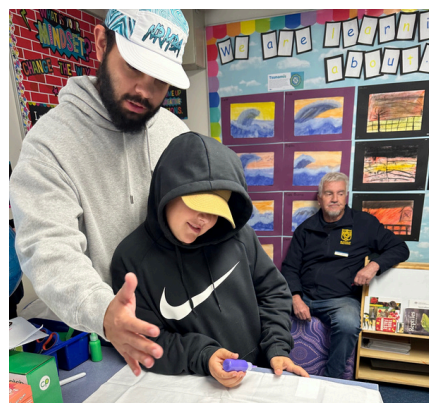
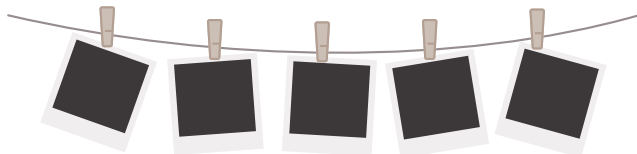
Small Schools Sports Day
